Community College?

On Monday 21st September, 2015 Ms. Carla Andersen from Lane Community College in Oregon, U.S.A. visited school and presented plenty of information to all GAC and Year 12 students (pics below). Lane offers a 2 + 2 = 4 - two years at the college and then two years at a chosen university to complete a four year degree. There were lots of questions from students, as the cost of attending community colleges is much lower than universities.
