Power-Point Tips

- Remember the 5 point rule:
 - No more than 5 points per slide.
 - No more than 5 sub points per main point.
- Make sure that text is easily readable.
- Keep transitions from slide to slide the same.
- Keep animations to text and animations to graphics all similar and constant.
- Remember to put all your references on the final slide.
