Topic Careful Monitoring on the spread of Respiratory Disease and Hand Foot Mouth Disease

To Parents

During raining season, the weather is hot, and it is easily for Respiratory Disease and Hand Foot Mouth Disease to spread if there is no prevention or serious monitoring for it.

Our school sets up measures to prevent and care in continuous cleaning and adding more measures in preventing unsanitary conditions. Be careful in checking such as:

1. Homeroom teachers will check nail, hair, teeth and skin of students in each grade on every morning and afternoon, and before going in the classroom and record anything abnormal or suspicious. Suspected students will be sent to the nurse to be thoroughly examined. After that, the class teacher will report to parents so that they can take the student to the doctor.
2. For the communal toys that the students use at school, they are always cleaned every day with soap and line them up in sunshine so that any germs are killed.
3. Always clean hands after activities and before having a meal.

**We are asking parents to please cooperate in carefully taking good care in your child's health. If your child has a cold or symptoms such as a fever, cough, sneeze, sore throat, tired, gasping for breath, please have your child rest at home until he/she is better before returning to school. If someone in the family has a cold or hand foot mouth disease, the student should stop coming to school to prevent the spread of the disease. In case if student is sick, parents please call to notify school and submit the doctor's certificate to the homeroom teacher or the admin office when coming back to class.**
