- 1. The Sports Carnival will be held from 08.45-11.30 am at Court 1 (in front of St. Dominic1 Bldg. and Bldg. 1). In the morning please send your child/children to school before 8.30 am. After the activity ends, normal classes will resume as well as afterschool classes. Parents can decide to pick up your child right after the event (if so, please contact your child's homeroom teacher to request for an "Early Leave Card") or let your child study and pick them up after school normally ends.
- 2. There are two rounds (two days) according to the students' year levels to encourage all students to participate with an emphasis on playing the sports games. Furthermore, they will be able to learn to win and to lose. In addition, we have focused on money saving. Hence, we would like to ask for your cooperation to refrain from organising team colour shirts and please let your child wear the shirts in the colour of their sports team (any style of the shirts they already have), school sports pants and trainers.
- 3. For parents who wish to join the event, please wear proper attire (same colour as your child), which is suitable for participating in various sports competitions. Please do not wear shorts, skirts, vests or sleeveless shirts.
- 4. On January 15<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> all areas at school will be reserved for organizing the event and also for conducting normal lessons for other year levels. Thus, there will be no parking spaces available on those days. Parents please use public transport only.
- 5. For Y.1 students, they will have an opportunity to observe the Sports Carnival of Primary and Secondary students in the morning of January 19<sup>th</sup> and return to study normal lessons in the afternoon.
