Put your name on all of your belongings to prevent it aetting lost or it being used by your friends.


- Container washing points are provided for Y.10-12 students
- For those who are allergic to alcohol, please bring vour own sanitizer.
- If you have medical problems, allergy to any kinds of food, medicine or chemical substances, please inform your homeroom teacher. Provided information will be used for preparing care-taking plans.

### Have your temperature measured before leaving home.

- Without fever, you can come to the school.
- With fever, please stay home. Or visit medical doctors **Submit sick leave**







# **Transportation**

## 1. Riding School Vans

- Students' temperature is measured by student minders before riding vans.
- Receive alcohol gel
- Students must wear a face mask at all times while riding school vans.
- Students are encouraged not to share food or drinks.

(After dropping off students, school vans will be sanitized with disinfectant and ventilated)



## 2. Parents who bring students to school

- Parents are not allowed to go upstairs into any building.
- Please pick up & drop off students during the specified time.
- Please put the student's name on your car's dashboard for quick and convenient call.
- To help reduce pollution, please leave the campus after dropping off / OR please turn off your car's engine whilst your car is idle.





- Please wear a face mask all the time.
- Everyone must have their temperature measured at any screening point. After checked, you will receive a sticker.





- Any student that has fever, the student's parents will be contacted to pick the student up. (Students will wait for their parents at an isolated room.)
- For students without fever, they will sit and wait at the provided area until they are allowed to enter classrooms.
- Wash your hands with soap for at least 20 seconds.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Stay distanced with your classmates.
- Avoid borrowing belongings of your friends.
- For secondary students, please leave your mobile phones at deposition points. (All mobile phones will be kept in zipped bags and sanitized with disinfectant.)
- If you wish to dispose of used face masks, please dispose of them in provided bins.
